#### On Day 1 The Event Focused on talks by mentors:

Event helped participants network with mentors & entrepreneurs who have experience in the field of Agriculture.

- Event started by giving an overview about Venture Center and Mentors followed by sharing information about Social Innovation immersion program: AgriTech Call 2021.
- This was followed by talk by mentor Mr. Nilesh Lele who gave participants tips and pointers for raising funds for AgriTech Startups. He focused on what is an investors point of view when they look at funding the startups.
- This session was followed by experiences from Startup founders working in AgriTech / Agri Inputs space. Very Interactive session where participants understood about real life experiences and challenges faced by entrepreneurs.
- This was followed by a session by Mr. Ashish Jangale about smart farming he gave several examples of precision & smart farming which helped participants to understand modern ways to detect soil health, carbon content in soil that helps farmers increase their yields. He also focused on role automated tractors and using help of robotics to plant the crops and harvesting the crops which is energy and time saving for farmers.


















The second part of the mixer consisted of one-on-one mentoring sessions where some selected participants had an opportunity to meet a mentor.
