About the **Event**

BRBC'S City Camp was organized on 23-24 September 2022 in collaboration with IIMN Foundation for Entrepreneurship Development (InFED, IIM Nagpur). The first day workshop, intended for budding entrepreneurs, introduced key aspects of scientific entrepreneurship such as innovation vs invention, value proposition, tech de-risking, and funding landscape. The second day workshop included talks on business plan, elevator pitch, financial simulation of startup and concluded with one-on-one mentoring sessions for selected entrepreneurs from mentors.

• The session conducted by Dr. Smita Kale discussed concepts like funding opportunities, understanding grant writing, Biotechnology Ignition Grant (BIG), tips & pointers for your BIG application.
