









Report | Venture Base Camp on Writing Winning Proposals (for innovation funding schemes with BIRAC Biotech Ignition Grant as Case Study)| Thurs-Sat | 11-13 Jan 2024

About the Event

Venture Base Camp (VBC) aimed at startups to learn exactly what you need to communicate about yourself and your business, by knowing the basics of grant writing. This three days workshop is designed to train entrepreneurs and business owners on how to write a good grant funding proposal that could potentially increase your chances of winning the grant! It introduced the participants to various sub-aspects of a grant proposal including value proposition, IP, business plan, project management and others along with one-on-one mentoring/guidance to help them in building their own project based grant funding proposal slides.













Content

DAY 1:

The first day of the workshop included the right balance of talks to understand concepts of value proposition, need identification, IP & FTO.

DAY2:

The second day began with a talk on team building, POC study, milestone planning, business plan and go-to-market strategy. Startups were allotted a designated time each day to work on their slides based on individual projects. In-house mentors/experts were available to guide them as needed.

DAY3:

The final day of the workshop, required participants to present their grant funding proposal slides in front of a jury of mentors, that provided them with real-time review/feedback and suggestions for improvement in their prepared slide deck
