About the Event

RIFC@BRBC's workshop was organized on 29th January 2024. It was organized as a RIFC's program with Mr. Akshay Joshi, Junior Innovation fellow (IIT Jodhpur - AIIMS Jodhpur), (MTech, IIT Delhi) as the guest speaker talking about Substantial Equivalence section from 510k route. Session Description

The session intended to provide information on the substantial equivalence aspect of the 510k process during the US FDA approval. The 510k route enables the start ups and entrepreneurs to leverage the available market data to establish the safety and efficacy of their medical device. Hence, the workshop emphasized on the techniques that can be utilised to identify the predicate device/c and establish the substantial equivalence.

The session began with an overview of Venture Center and RIFC by Mr. Akash Dhade, and was followed by Akshay's talk on the Background, details about the US FDA market and explanation of the main routes to get US FDA approvals for medical devices. The session concluded with Akshay showcasing the substantial equivalence format based on the case studies and question answer session.
